These are just a few suggestions; please do not feel compelled to cover every issue.

Scholarship Award Amount & Recognition:

The amount and the number of scholarships will be determined by the LBAWSF Board of Directors, but is typically \$1,000. To receive their award, all scholarship recipients are expected to attend the annual Latina/o Bar Association of Washington (LBAW) awards dinner, to be held this January 25, 2008. Scholarship recipients at the banquet will be guests of the LBAWSF. Additional banquet tickets can be purchased from the LBAW directly. A special stipend will be given to defray costs for recipients who must travel from schools across the state to attend the banquet.
